

Church School: It's Not Just for Kids, Anymore!

Are you ready to grow more in your spirituality? How about deepen your biblical knowledge? What about exploring the intersection of faith and the world? Well, we've got a class for you!
(All classes meet from 9:30am-10:30am on Sundays, unless otherwise indicated)

Chapel Class

The class delves deeply into the Bible, placing an emphasis on a collegial reading of the Bible, one book at a time, with reflections, questions, and other discussion as they go. They combine a focus on what the scriptures meant to the early hearers as well as how we hear it speaking to us today. There is also attention given to how the passages being studied relate to other parts of the Bible. (Meets in the Chapel)

Connections Class

This class takes a unique approach to studying the Christian life - reading books and literature about religion and faith, exploring videos on the Bible and church history and even breaking out the religion section of the newspaper to take on a new topic of interest - whatever medium will open discussions on the interconnections between faith and the world. The class is currently viewing the DVD series, "Saving Jesus", a study of Jesus for the 3rd millennium. (Meets in Room 212 beside the Choir Room at 9:45am)

Covenant Life Class

In this class you will delve into the Bible using *The Present Word*, the denominational curriculum. The class elects to move through the lessons at their own pace - discussing and debating what they are studying. (Meets in Room 207 next to the elevator at 10:00am)

Encountering the Word

In this class, folks gather together to explore the Bible text for the sermon on a particular Sunday through thoughtful exploration. No Bible scholars here, just an opportunity to have a deeper understanding of the Bible and how its messages intersect with our lives, everyday. Vanguard Class

This class explores the Bible through *The Present Word*, the denominational curriculum, discovering new ways of understanding the scriptures in historical and cultural context, and discerning how that applies to our everyday lives, all while developing a strong class dynamic that "feels like family." (Meets in the Board Room/Room 114, next to the stage)
